

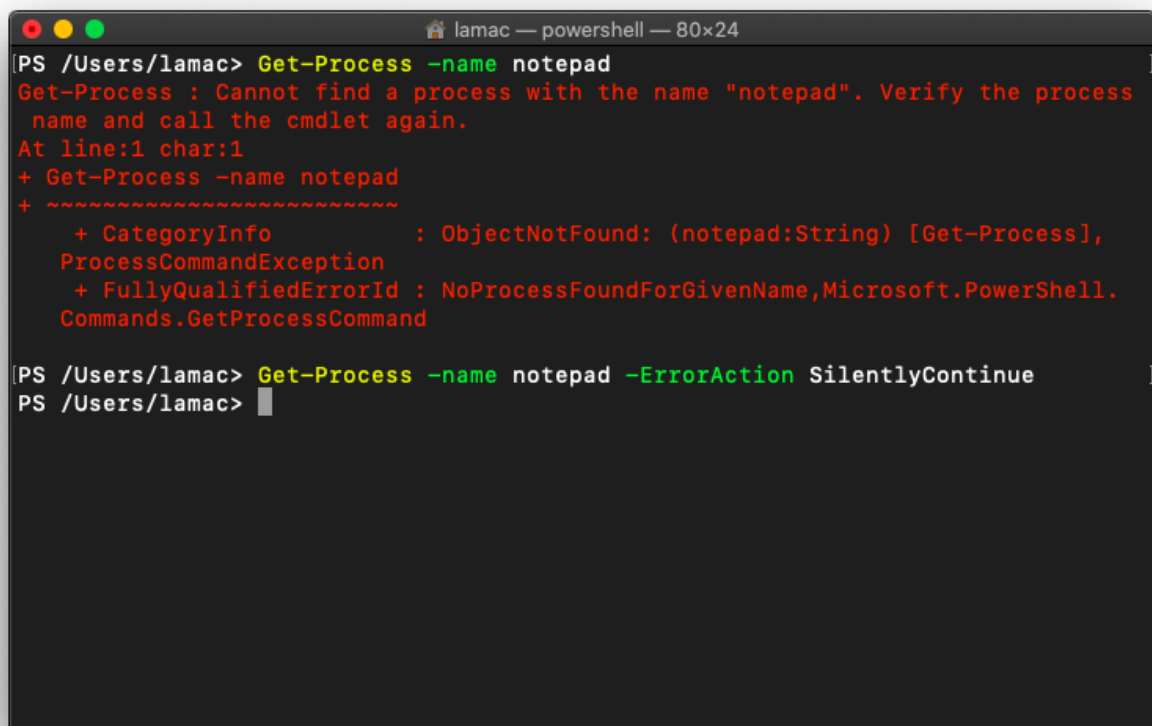
Ignorar errores en PowerShell

Agregar al cmdlet lo siguiente:

`-ErrorAction SilentlyContinue`

Ejemplo: no mostrar errores cuando el proceso no se encuentre utilizando el cmdlet `Get-Process`
