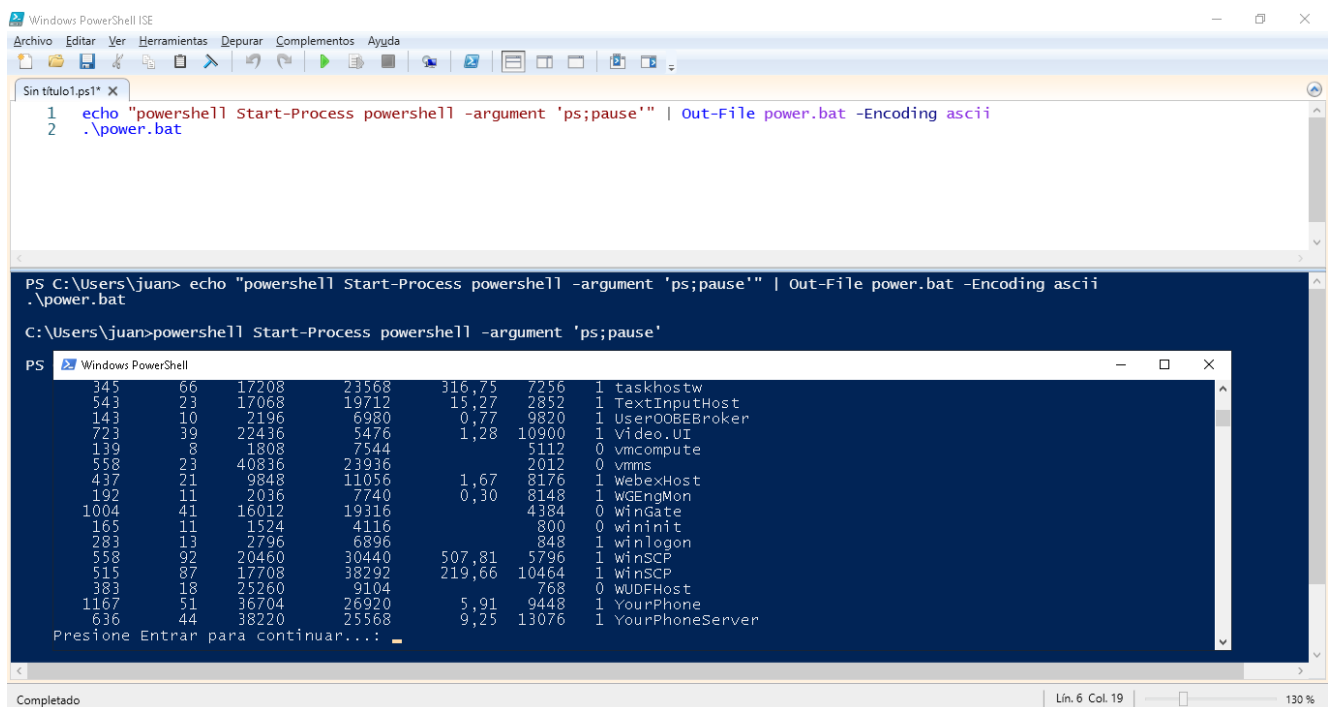


Crear un fichero .bat que ejecute un script de PowerShell

En DOS, OS/2 y Microsoft Windows, un archivo batch es un archivo de procesamiento por lotes. Se trata de archivos de texto sin formato, guardados con la extensión .BAT que contienen un conjunto de instrucciones MS-DOS.
