

Crear un archivo JSON con la programación de Movistar+

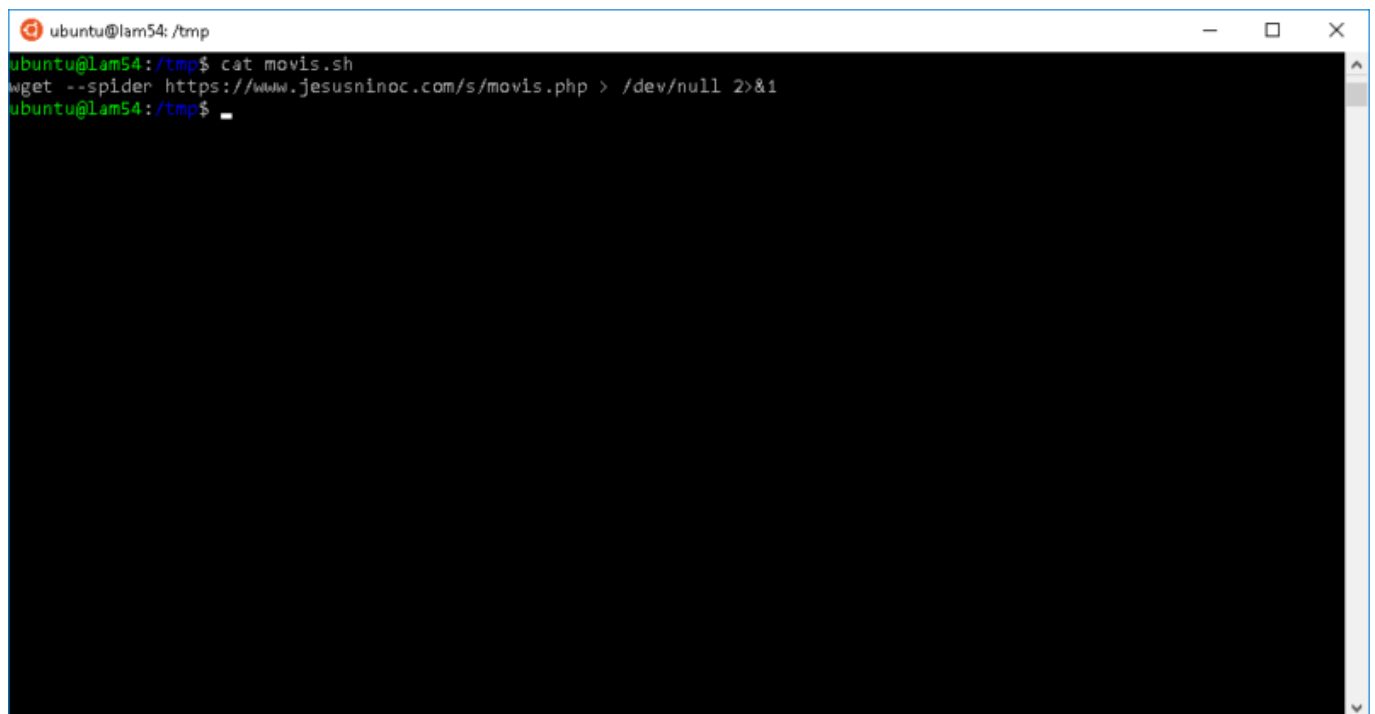

Fichero movis.php que crea el fichero movistar.php

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Crear un script que se llame movis.sh con el siguiente comando
