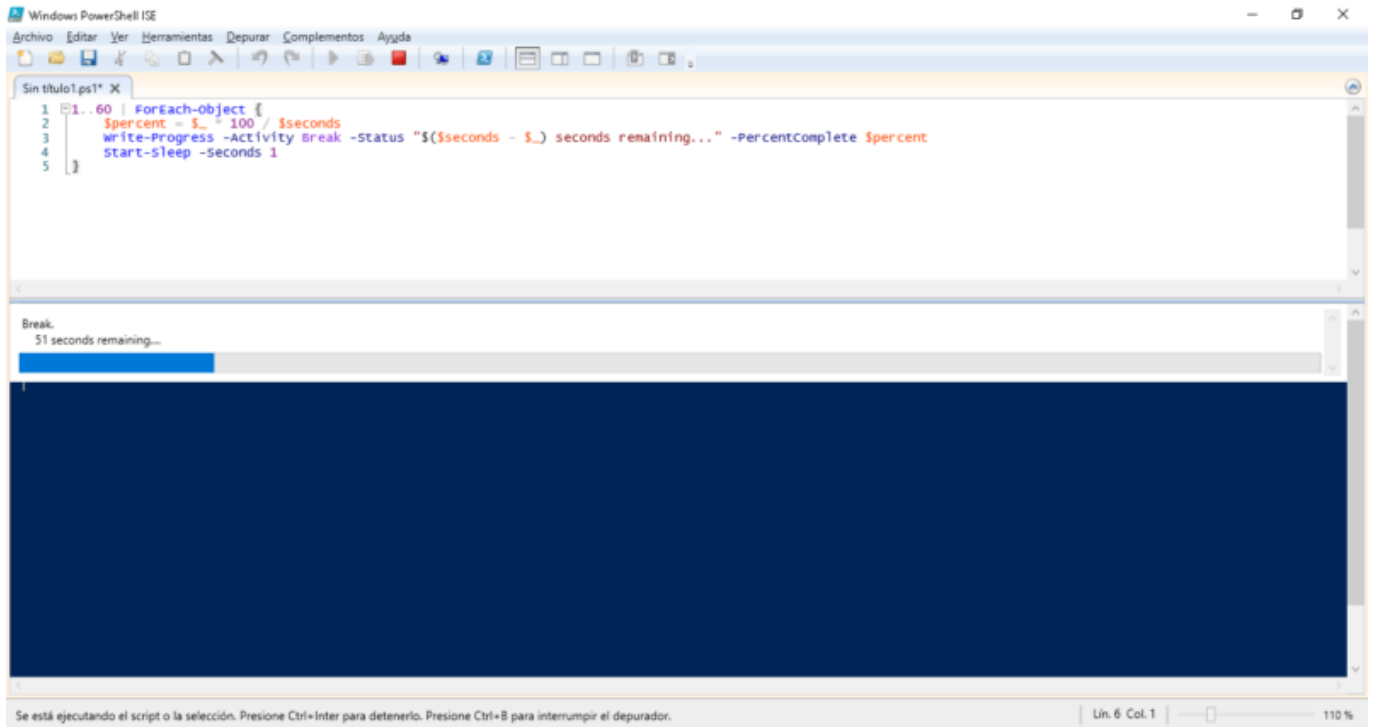


# Crear una barra de progreso en PowerShell
