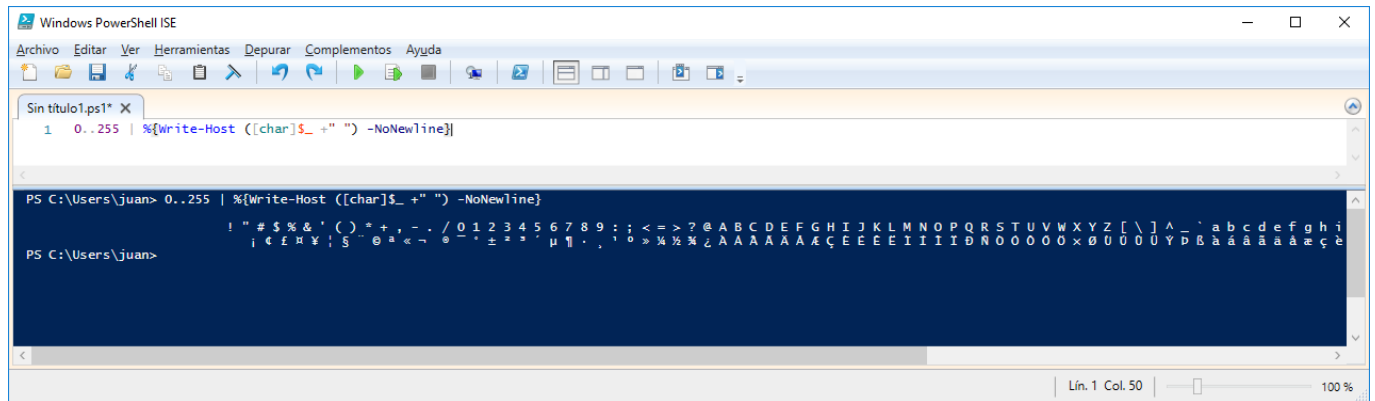


Use PowerShell to display ASCII characters
